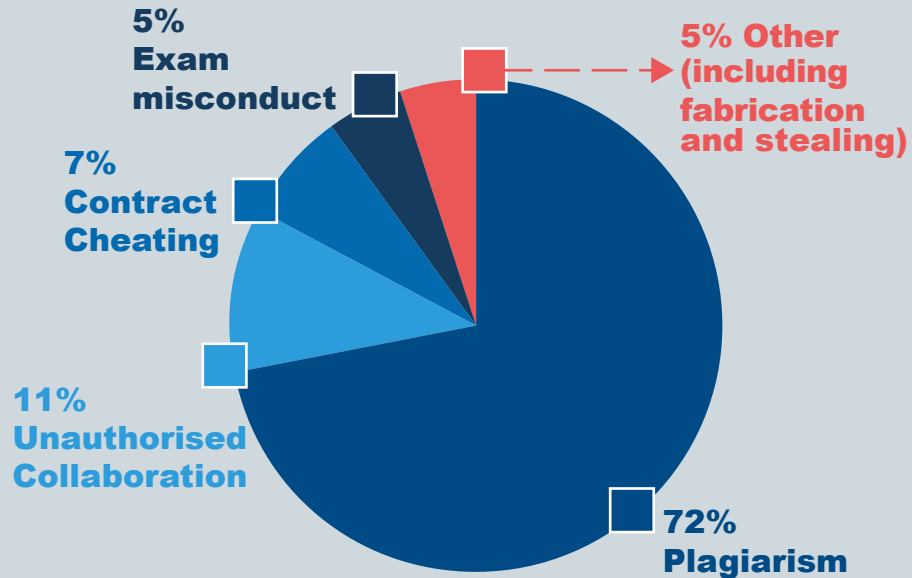

When part or all of your assignment is completed by someone else, this is 'contract cheating'. You will probably fail the unit or be suspended from ECU if this happens.



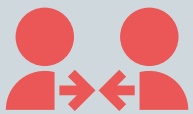
I didn't want to receive a late penalty, but getting fewer marks would have been better than failing the unit for forging a medical certificate.
